The St. Nicholas Fund, inspired by the philanthropic legacy of St. Nicholas, Bishop of Myra, seeks to emulate a commitment to charity and relief from poverty.

Co-founded by a small group of entrepreneurs and operated by City In Focus, a registered non-profit now in its 36th year in operation, the St. Nicholas fund focuses on providing timely, nimble, boots-on-the-ground assistance and pastoral care to the most vulnerable in our local community.

The recipients include a wide range of individuals and smaller charitable organizations whose efforts directly aid single parents, women, children, seniors, refugees, immigrants, those struggling with homelessness, addiction, lonliness, mental ill-health, food insecurity and more.


The Fund has already distributed more than \$2M, positively impacting hundreds of families.

#### Stories of lives touched...

- Last Christmas, a struggling single mother of four found herself facing an unexpected challenge when her sister tragically passed away, leaving behind three young children. Without hesitation, the mother took in her three nieces and nephews.
  - In an effort to bring some joy and relief, we immediately sent \$1,000 and followed up with both pastoral support and contacts for further assistance, ensuring the family was able to enjoy a festive meal and exchange gifts as they adjusted to their new life together.
- Over the years we have provide numerous grants to ensure that low income children in East Vancouver can take music lessons for free and have a good meal every day after school.

- We support the CLEAN Break Program (Community Laundry Enterprise Assisting Neighbours). The program runs out of a laundromat on Commercial Drive and is coordinated by a volunteer who hosts homeless or poorly housed neighbours who do not have access to laundry services, with donated coffee, tea, and refreshments.
- A retired grandmother, single-handedly raising her grandson after the tragic loss of his mother to overdose and with the father battling drug addiction, receives annual financial support from us. This assistance aims to ease the burden of providing a stable and nurturing environment for the child amidst challenging circumstances
- We provided a \$1,000 gift to a pastor. This funding supported him in articulating his vision for caring for those living on the streets in the downtown Eastside. In the years that followed, he, along with many volunteers, was able to turn his vision into reality, offering continuous support and care to hundreds of those in need.





## Together, we make a difference.

This past year the St. Nicholas Fund helped over 400 people, many of them families with children.

Cash or financial gifts to our recipients usually range from \$200 to \$2,500.

They are often given directly, especially when time is of the essence, but we also extend our reach through partnerships with other charities and non-profits, many of which City In Focus has had the pleasure of working with for many years.

#### St Nicholas of Myra

Inheriting great wealth in his youth, St. Nicholas devoted his life to practicing charity, particularly for the poor and marginalized. He viewed his resources as a divine gift to be shared with those in need and became widely venerated for his generosity, compassion and anonymous gift-giving, which over time evolved into the modern figure of Santa Claus.



One poignant story involved rescuing a family trapped by dire financial hardship. On three separate nights, St. Nicholas anonymously threw bags of gold through the family's window, providing dowries for three daughters who otherwise would have been sold into slavery.
